

Highbury Tennis Club Information for Matches & Finding Courts

We play Summer League matches at **Highbury Fields**. Winter League matches will be played at both Highbury Fields and **Rosemary Gardens**. The relevant Team Captain will let you know which venue is being used in advance of the match.

Highbury Fields

Floodlights & Timings

We book match courts from 6.00pm-9.00pm when the park shuts and the lights are switched off. It is therefore a good idea **if we start as early as possible.**

Loos & Drinking Fountain

We have 2 Portaloos that don't charge for use.
There is a drinking fountain for refilling water bottles.

Post-Match Supper

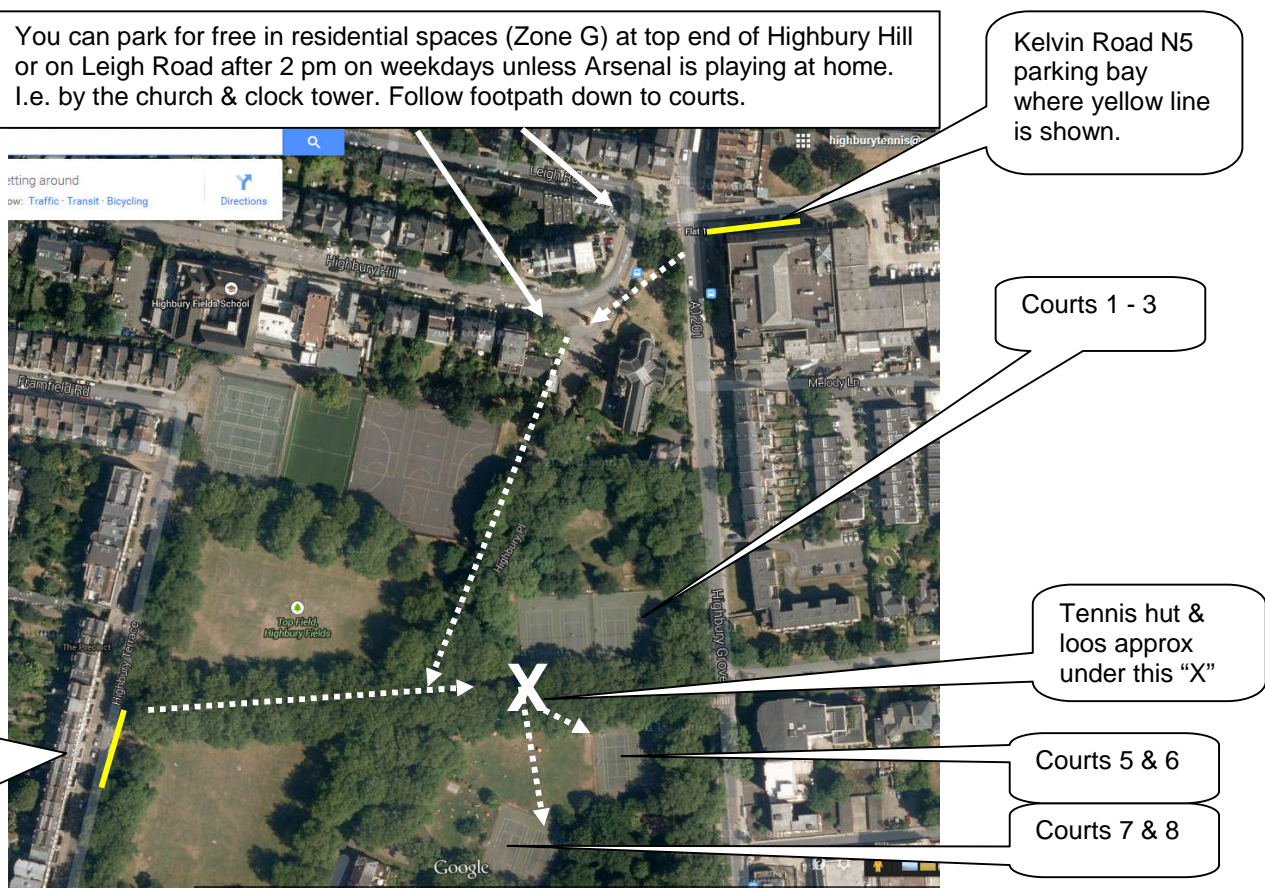
We will take you to a local pizza restaurant or pub a 5 minute walk away or convene at one of our player's houses. (We don't have a club house).

Travel

There's free parking on weekdays after 2.00pm in Zone G at the top end of Highbury Hill or on Leigh Road. See map below. If there are no spaces here, try Kelvin Road for paid-for parking or use postcode N5 1UP for Highbury Terrace where you can park on the right hand side (not on the first 25 metres or so) and pay and display, both charge up to 6.30pm after which it is free.

IMPORTANT RESTRICTION If there is an Arsenal home match it is impossible to park nearby before 8.30pm so come by public transport. Check for match info here:

We usually play on courts 1, 2 &/or 3, next to the road just past the hut marked with an X. We sometimes play on Courts 7 & 8 (& 6 in the summer) so check with the Highbury captain.

By Tube & Train
